



## COLOURS NOMINATION FORM 2018

Colours will be awarded for Service, Culture and Sports on Friday 28 September.

If you are in Years 12 or 13 and believe that you are eligible to be awarded Colours in any of these areas, then:

1. Read carefully the criteria set out below.
2. Fill out the reverse page of this application form addressing the criteria.
3. DO NOT attach any other pages.
4. Make sure you add your name and signature where indicated.
5. If your activity is one that is coached at school by a staff member you must obtain their signature on your application.
6. If no staff member is involved add the name of someone who, if called on, can verify what you have provided in your application.
7. Staff may also make nominations so it is probably best to discuss your application with any staff member involved.
8. You can receive Colours again as a Y13 student if you received them in Y12 but there should be evidence of ongoing high performance or new achievements.
9. You must hand this form to **MRS EDMONDS no later than 11:00am on FRIDAY 31 AUGUST.**
10. No late applications will be considered.
